Montreux

There are also shorter trips to such places as the walled village of Gruyères with its château and famous Gruyère cheese factory. Close to this is the Nestlé chocolate factory at Broc, a big favourite with many students since they are allowed to sample the various types of chocolate created there. The provincial town of Bulle with the Gruyèrian Museum is nearby, as are many picturesque alpine villages such as Château d'Oex and Gstaad, combining all the quaint charm of traditional Switzerland with international renown.
