

The Centre provides twin, triple and quadruple rooms. The majority of rooms have French windows leading out onto large south facing balconies, pleasant for sun-bathing in both summer and winter or admiring the breath-taking views. All rooms are provided with hot and cold water and a number of shower rooms and toilets are located on each floor. The Centre can house up to 110 students.

An intercom system installed on the ground floor and servicing all floors, enables staff to make quick contact with people for telephone calls etc., and a lift service enables luggage to be moved rapidly from one floor to the next. The ground floor is the focal point of the house and invites students of various courses to get together in its many high ceilinged rooms to enjoy a number of activities. The solariums at either end of the corridor are equipped with table-tennis tables, table-football facilities, pool tables and video games.

The snack bar has a vending machine for drinks and sweets. During summer courses students may enjoy the bar terrace where a choice of ice-creams is also on sale. The bar also has a wide selection of board games. Next to the bar and very popular entertainment, is the disco room.

The Television room is equipped with large screen satellite T. V. and DVD home cinema system. The Centre also provides an up to date video and DVD library in English, French and German.

A second salon furnished with comfortable sofas and arm-chairs provides a welcome area for those who wish to sit and talk, or simply read a book . It is also equipped with notice boards informing students of each course about the weeks activities and providing useful information.

Also on the ground floor the Centre has two dining rooms.

The large dining room can seat up to 90 people comfortably with the second dining room providing space for a further 40 people. A terrace running the length of the house enables people to eat outside in the warmer weather and a pleasant barbecue area in the garden makes a welcome change to the more formal atmosphere of the dining room.

The reception area provides telephone facilities for course students and fax facilities are also available on demand.

To the left of the communal rooms are the classrooms situated far enough away from the bar and games areas to provide the necessary calm inducive to work.

The fitness and aerobics room is located on the lower ground floor, as are the art and craft and ski rooms. In conclusion, thanks to its south facing position and large French windows in almost every room, the house enjoys an enormous amount of space and light which helps to ensure a pleasant stay for all its guests.
