The Music Academy is a programme for those campers that love contemporary music. Whether you have existing musical skills or simply the desire to enjoy music, this programme provides the opportunity to get together with like minded campers under the guidance of our professional staff and jam, perform, rehearse, learn about and create music.

Three hours every day the Music Academy campers gather in our rehearsal studio to work on the music that they will be recording as well as playing for the rest of camp. From digital music to classical, rock to hip hop campers are encouraged to learn about music and different ways of making it. The importance of teamwork in both playing in a band as well as in putting a song together is stressed and during the session we will be making recordings and giving performances of the music we have created.

Martin Gjerstad, our program director, is a highly trained musician, music teacher and arranger/producer who has been involved in pop bands, musical productions and recording studios. The goal of this program is to build on the camper's skills and love of music to create, perform and make music.

Thanks to the different musical skills and interests of our campers every session is a little different and we focus our programme based on these factors. Typically we also introduce new instruments, technology, music production and styles of music to the campers as well as working on the creative side. If you have an instrument please bring it along or feel free to use any of the ones we have at camp.

In the afternoons and evenings the music campers join the other campers participating in the variety of other camp activities on offer.
